

Textiles, Tikal, and Traditions

A seven-night trip showcasing adventure, artisans, culture, and cuisine in Guatemala

Your curated trip begins with four nights in charming Antigua, where you will enjoy Guatemala's most enchanting city. Exclusive experiences with local artisans and culinary experts will immerse you in a truly unique local perspective of Guatemala's culture. You'll spend the next three nights in the Petén region near the magnificent Tikal Maya ruins. There you'll enjoy idyllic lakeside lounging and soak up Maya history.

This journey happens May 6-13, 2023 and is limited to 14 travelers.

Itinerary

Day 1 - Saturday, May 6

Arrive in Guatemala City then enjoy the beautiful volcano landscapes as you transfer via car into the Antigua valley. Check into <u>Posada del Angel</u> and settle into your guestroom before you venture up to the roof terrace to view El Fuego volcano in all its glory while enjoying snacks and beverages. Get to know your traveling companions over a convivial dinner at a local restaurant just a stroll away from the hotel.

Day 2 - Sunday, May 7

Experience an afternoon at <u>Luna Zorro Studio</u> for a natural dyes workshop and artisan textile weaving demonstration. At the studio's on-site kitchen and garden restaurant, you'll savor a privately catered lunch and natural wine tasting and pairing. Head back to Posada del Angel and have the rest of the day and evening to yourself for time to rest, or shop and explore locally. Enjoy dinner on your own in beautiful Antigua, selecting from a list of our most highly recommended spots in town.

Day 3 - Monday, May 8

Enjoy a free day to explore Antigua on your own. Shop, dine, or seek out adventures. Join our early evening tour and hosted happy hour experience at FUNBA art museum and sculpture gardens showcasing the world's largest private collection of Guatemalan art.

Day 4 - Tuesday, May 9

Enjoy another day on your own to explore. Gather with the group in the late afternoon for beverages and a curated retail experience showcasing antique Guatemalan textiles and other artisan pieces at Casa De Artes.

Day 5 - Wednesday, May 10

Depart early morning for a delicious, organic farm-to-table breakfast experience at Caoba Farms. The adventure continues as you head to Guatemala City airport to board a private charter flight to Flores (approx. a 50 min flight). Take in the sights of serene Lake Petén Itza (45 minute boat ride) to La Lancha. Arrive and enjoy a lite lunch and welcome drinks dockside before you settle into your dwelling. Join the group for a barbecue dinner.

Day 6 - Thursday, May 11

Savor an early morning breakfast while viewing the lake from La Lancha's al fresco restaurant before departing to magical Tikal with a guided full-day tour, including lunch. Return late afternoon to play on the lake, or resin in your peaceful surroundings. Later, get hands on and learn how to make delicious corn tortillas over an authentic Guatemalan comal. The evening will be yours to enjoy as you please. Plan to have dinner at your leisure in La Lancha's restaurant or in-room dining at your dwelling.

Day 7 - Friday, May 12

Enjoy breakfast and the Temazcal Maya sauna experience at your leisure followed by a free day on your own to explore and add on <u>additional activities</u>. Enjoy a boat ride over to Flores to dine at a local restaurant.

Afterwards, you'll be driven back to La Lancha for a restful evening.

Day 8 - Saturday, May 13

Say your goodbyes over breakfast before heading to the airport. We hope you leave Guatemala feeling inspired by the warmth and spirit of the local people, their rich culture and traditional artistry, as well as the beauty of the stunning natural landscapes you enjoyed on your trip.
